- Are eager to grow personally and professionally through hands-on learning, collaboration, and civic engagement.
- Are committed to fully participating in all program sessions and graduation.
- Live or work in Columbia County or Greene County.

INSTRUCTIONS: The application process includes steps outlined below and a brief interview. All applications are reviewed competitively. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

To apply, **submit the following**:

- 1. A completed and signed application form (including employer signature).
- 2. A one-page professional résumé, including your highest level of education.
- 3. A list of civic, professional, or community organizations you are or have been involved with, including any leadership roles.
- 4. Two professional references (name, relationship, and phone number) who can speak to your leadership potential.

Completed applications must be emailed, mailed or delivered to your Chamber of Commerce by 5 PM on **Thursday**, **July 31**, **2025**.

Each applicant will be interviewed by the Leadership Columbia-Greene Committee. Interviews will be held in **August 2025**. All applicants will be notified of acceptance by the end of August 2025.

ACCEPTANCE & TUITION:

Upon acceptance into the Leadership Columbia-Greene Program, the tuition of \$1,600 must be paid via check in full to the "Columbia County Chamber Foundation" no later than September 1, 2025. **Tuition is Non-Refundable.**

Attendance at all eight (8) full-day sessions (one Tuesday a month from October to May) is **required**. Participants who have more than two (2) unexcused absences will not receive a certificate of completion from the program and employer will be notified.
