**CRITERIA:** For the 2026–27 program year, Leadership Columbia-Greene will welcome a cohort of up to 18 diverse, high-potential individuals.

Ideal candidates:

- Are passionate about making a lasting impact in their workplace and in the Columbia–Greene community.
- Are eager to grow personally and professionally through hands-on learning, collaboration, and civic engagement.
- Are committed to fully participating in all program sessions and graduation.
- Live or work in Columbia County or Greene County.

**INSTRUCTIONS:** The application process includes steps outlined below and a brief interview. All applications are reviewed competitively. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

To apply, **submit the following:**

1. A completed and signed application form (including employer signature).
2. A one-page professional résumé, including your highest level of education.
3. A list of civic, professional, or community organizations you are or have been involved with, including any leadership roles.
4. Two professional references (name, relationship, and phone number) who can speak to your leadership potential.

Completed applications must be emailed, mailed or delivered to your Chamber of Commerce by 5 PM on **Friday, July 31, 2026.**

Each applicant will be interviewed by the Leadership Columbia-Greene Committee. Interviews will be held in **August 2026.** All applicants will be notified of acceptance by the end of August 2026.

**Session 6: Public Safety, Policy, & Justice Systems** – Understanding law enforcement, EMS, emergency management, the judicial system, and public policy. (March 9, 2027)

**Session 7: Workplace Culture & Team Success** – Building equitable, diverse, and inclusive environments. (April 13, 2027)

**Session 8: Strategic Planning & Measuring Impact** – Tools for setting goals, measuring outcomes, and creating lasting change. (May 11, 2027)

**ACCEPTANCE & TUITION:**

Notification of selection into the Leadership Columbia-Greene Class of 2026-27 will be made by September 2026. Upon acceptance into the Leadership Columbia-Greene Program, the tuition of \$1,600 must be paid via check in full to the “*Columbia County Chamber Foundation*” no later than September 15, 2026. **Tuition is Non-Refundable.**

**COMMITMENT:**

Attendance at all eight (8) full-day sessions (one Tuesday a month from October to May) is **required**. Participants who have more than two (2) unexcused absences will not receive a certificate of completion from the program and employer will be notified.
